TWO HALVES MAKE A DIFFERENT WHOLE.

If you want to try a different boilie presentation that's quick and easy to do, try fishing two halves back to back.

All you need to do is chop a boilie in half and put the two sections on the hair back to back. This exposes the inside of the boilie and also increases the surface area, which flavours can leak from quickly. You must be careful when doing this that the sections don't break off on the cast or get pulled off by silver fish, because as the surface area of the boilie is much larger it soaks up more water and becomes softer. This presentation can prove very effective when fished over crushed or broken boilies as it has the same broken up look as the free offerings.
