TRIM YOUR BOILIE TO A DIFFERENT SHAPE

It is often possible to fool wary carp by changing the shape of your boilie. This is simple to do and can prove very effective, especially on hard fished waters where the carp may be wary of regular, round boilies.

All you need to do is mount your boilie on a hair as normal and then trim the sides with a pair of scissors. You can make whatever shape you like - one of the most popular is a pellet shape.

Not only does this change the shape, it also releases more flavour as bits of the boilie skin have been removed. This presentation can prove very effective when fished over crushed or broken boilies as it has the same broken up look as the free offerings.
